

# Important Things For You to Remember About...



## Bloodborne Pathogens

Pathogenic microorganisms that are present in human blood and can cause disease to humans. You have a right to know about:

- Our written program
- Hazardous Chemical list
- Material safety data sheets

### Infection can occur with:

- Contact with broken skin
- Contact with mucus membranes

### Exposure Potential

- Caring for an ill/injured person
- Cleaning blood/body fluid

### Preventing Exposure

- Wear PPE
- Clean all contacted surfaces
- Wash hands
- Hepatitis B Vaccination

### Universal Precautions

- Can't detect infected people
- Treat all body fluids as if infected

### Personal Protective Equipment

- Safety glasses
- Apron/suit/shoe covers
- Face shield
- Barrier mask
- Disposable gloves

### Clean-Up

- Use sanitizer
- Bag when necessary
- Wipe all surfaces

### Exposure Incident

- Wash/flush area and report to your supervisor
