Fire Extinguisher Use and Your Safety

- FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ARE DESIGNED FOR SMALL FIRES ONLY!
- IF A FIRE IS TOO LARGE, IF THERE IS TOO MUCH SMOKE OR YOU ARE TOO FRIGHTENED, DO NOT USE THE FIRE EXTINGUISHER-EVACUATE!
- DON'T FIGHT A FIRE IF YOUR INSTINCTS SAY EVACUATE.

CLASSES OF FIRE

Class A-Ordinary Combustibles
Class B-Flammable liquids/gasses
Class C-Energized electrical
Class D-Metals
Class K-Cooking media

TYPES OF EXTINGUISHERS

Dry Chemical
Carbon Dioxide
Water/Foam
Halon/Halon Substitute
Class K

FIRE EXTINGUISHER OPERATION

Remember: PASS

- P = Pull the Pin
- A Aim at the base
- S Squeeze the lever
- S Sweep side to side
